The Words of Jesus from the Four Gospels

LK 2:10 Jesus said, "Do not be afraid! Listen carefully, for I proclaim to you good news that brings great joy to all the people"

John 14:1-2 Jesus said: Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in Father, believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

Mt 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.

Mt. 5:4 "Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted"

Mt 6:31 So then, don't worry saying, 'What will we eat?' or 'What will we drink?' or 'What will we wear?' Look at the birds in the sky: They do not sow, or reap, or gather into barns, yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Aren't you more valuable than they are?

Mt 6:34 So then, do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself.

Mt 6:27 And which of you by worrying can add even one hour to his life?

Mt 7:11 If you then as weak as you are know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him.

Mt 9:36 When Jesus saw the crowds, he had compassion on them

Mt 10:31 So do not be afraid; you are more valuable than many sparrows

LK 1:50 from generation to generation Yah is merciful

LK 1:78 Because of our God's tender mercy the dawn will break upon us from on high to give light to those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death.

MT 11:28 Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, because I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your lives. For my yoke is easy to bear, and my load is not hard to carry."

MT 13:16 " your eyes are blessed because they see, and your ears because they hear

Lk 6:21 "Blessed are you who weep now, for you will laugh

LK 6:36 your Father is merciful.

JN 1:17 For the law was given through Moses, but grace came about through Jesus

JN 3:18 The one who believes in him is not condemned.

JN 5:22 Furthermore, the Father does not judge anyone

JN 8:12 Then Jesus spoke out again, "I am the light of the world. The one who follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

JN 10:9 I am the door. If anyone enters through me, he will be saved,

JN 12:46 I have come as a light into the world, so that everyone who believes in me should not remain in darkness.

MT 18:14 In the same way, your Father in heaven is not willing that one of these little ones be lost.

MT 20:34 Moved with compassion, Jesus touched their eyes.

MT 21:22 And whatever you ask in prayer, if you believe, you will receive."

Jn 1:10-12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the children of God,

even to them that believe on his name.

Jn 3:15 That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life.

John3: 16-18 For Father so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For Father sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. He that believes on him is not condemned:

Jn 3:35-36 Jesus said: Father loves the Son, and has given all things into his hand. He that believes on the Son has everlasting life:

Jn 5:24 Jesus said: Verily, verily, I say unto you, whoever hears my words, and believes on him that sent me, has everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death to life.

Joh 6:35 I am the bread of life: he that comes to me shall never hunger; and he that believes on me shall never thirst.

Jesus said:

Mt 6:14-15 “ if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive your trespasses.

John 10:10 For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them

Jn 10:27-29 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give to them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. My Father, which gave them to me, and is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.

JN14:18 Jesus said, “I will not abandon you.”

JN 15:15 I no longer call you slaves, ... But I have called you friends

Lu 9:56 Jesus said: I am come that they might have everlasting life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

Lu 12:32 Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

Jn 15:11 These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full.

Jn 20:31 These are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.

John 15:9 Jesus said, “As the father has loved me so have I loved you.

Jn 15:3 Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.

Jn 5:24 Verily, verily, I say to you, whoever hears my words, and believes on him that sent me, has everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death to life.

JN 16:21 When a woman gives birth, she has distress because her time has come, but when her child is born, she no longer remembers the suffering.

JN 16:4 But I have told you these things so that when their time comes, you will remember that I told you about them.

Jn 14:18 Jesus said: I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.

Jn 14:27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give you: not as the world gives, give I to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Jn 16:33 Jesus said, I have told you these things so that in me you may have peace. In the world you have trouble and suffering, but take courage – I have conquered the world.”

J n 17:13 Jesus said: I am saying these things, so you may experience my joy completed in yourself.

Jn 16:17 your hearts will be filled with joy, the kind of joy that no one can take away from you.

Rom 14:23 For the kingdom of God is Joy

1Pe 1:8 rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory:

Jud 1:24 Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,

From the Epistles of Paul

2 Cor 1:3 God is the Father of mercies and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles.

Gal 3:26 For in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith.

2 Cor 5:1 For we know that if our earthly house, (the tent we live in), is dismantled, we have a building from God, a new house/ a new body not built by human hands, that is eternal in the heavens.

2 Cor 4:14 We know that the one who raised up Jesus will also raise us up

Eph 3:20 Our God is able to do far beyond all that we ask or think

Gal 1:3 Grace and peace to you from God the Father and Jesus who gave himself for our sins to rescue us from this present evil age according to the will of our God and Father,

Gal 2:20 So the life I now live in the body, I live because of the faithfulness of the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Eph 2:4 But God, being rich in mercy, because of his great love with which he loved us, even though we were dead in sins, made us alive together with Jesus – by grace you are saved and to demonstrate in the coming ages the surpassing wealth of his grace in kindness toward us in Jesus (Yahshuah).

Phil 3:21 our Master Yahshuah, will transform these humble bodies of ours into the likeness of his glorious New body

Phil 4:6 Do not be anxious about anything. Instead, in every situation, through prayer and petition with thanksgiving, tell your requests to Yah the supreme Elohim of the Elohim. And the peace of God that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.

Col 1:22 Jesus has reconciled you by his physical body through death to present you holy, without blemish, and blameless before the Father.

Col 1:12 joyfully give thanks to the Father who has qualified you to share in the saints' inheritance in the light He delivered you from the power of darkness and transferred you to the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom you have redemption, and the forgiveness of sins.

2 Thes 3:3 The Lord God is faithful, and he will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one.

2 Thes 2:13 God chose you from the beginning for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth He called you to this salvation through the gospel, so that you may possess the glory of our master the Messiah.

1 Thess 5:3 He who calls you is trustworthy, and he will in fact do this.

1 Tim 2:5 The Messiah Jesus, himself human, gave himself as a ransom for all,

Phil 4:19 And God will supply your every need according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.

2 Tim 1:9 God is the one who saved us and called us with a holy calling, not based on our works but on his own purpose and grace, granted to us in Christ Yahshuah

Titus 2:11 For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all people.

Rom 8:1-2 But “when the kindness of God our Savior and his love for mankind appeared, he saved us not by works of righteousness that we have done but on the basis of his mercy, through the washing of the new birth and the renewing of the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us in full measure through Jesus The Messiah our human Savior. And so, since we have been justified by his grace, we become heirs with the confident expectation of eternal life.”

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in the Messiah Jesus: ... For the law of the Spirit of life in the Messiah Jesus hath made us free from the law of sin and death.

Rom 8:15-18 I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

Rom 8:24 We were saved with this hope in mind. If we hope for something we already see, it's not really hope. Who hopes for what can be seen?

Rom 8:25 But if we hope for what we don't see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance.

Rom 8:26 At the same time the Spirit also helps us in our weakness, because we don't know how to pray for what we need. But the Spirit intercedes

Rom 8:27 The one who searches our hearts knows what the Spirit has in mind. The Spirit intercedes for God's people the way God wants him to.

Rom 8:28 We know that all things work together for good to those who love God-those whom he has called according to his plan.

Rom 8:29 Yahshuah, his Son Jesus is the firstborn among many children.

Rom 8:31 And having chosen us, He called us to come to him: and when we came, he declared us not guilty filled us with the Messiah's goodness, and gave us right standing with himself and promised his shekinah glory. What can we ever say to such wonderful things as these? If Father is on our side who can ever be against us? ..won't he also surely give us everything else. Who dares accuse us whom Father has chosen for his own? Will God? No! He is the one who has forgiven us and given us right standing with himself. Who then will condemn us? Will Jesus the Messiah? NO! For he is the one who died for us and came back to life again for us and is sitting at the highest place of honor next to Father and is interceding for us there in heaven.

Rom 8:35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

Rom 8:36 As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.

Rom 8:37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

Rom 8:39 Who then can keep Jesus's love from us? When we have trouble or calamity, when we are hunted down or destroyed, is it because he doesn't love us anymore? No. Or if we are hungry, or penniless, or in danger, or threatened with death, has Father deserted us? No! For the Scriptures tell us that for his sake we must be ready to face death at every moment of the day. ... For I am convinced that nothing can separate us from his love. Death can't and life can't. The angels won't and all the power of hell cannot keep his love away Nor can our fears for today or our worries for tomorrow... Whether we are high above the sky, or in the deepest ocean, nothing will ever be able to separate us from the love of Father demonstrated by our Lord Jesus the Messiah (Living New Testament)

2Ti 1:7 For Father hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

Philp 1:6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus the Messiah.

1Thes 4: 16 -18 For God himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet and those who died believing in Jesus (Yahshuah) the Messiah shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet Father in the air: and so shall we ever be with Yah our father.

Eph 5:14 Wherefore Abba says, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Jesus the Messiah shall give thee light.

1Th 5:24 Faithful is he that called you, who also will do it.

2Th 3:3 God is faithful, he will establish you, and keep you from evil.

2 cor 4 :8-11 “We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed;

2Co 4:17 For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, works for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory;

Col.1:13 Abba has delivered us from the power of darkness, and has translated [us] into the kingdom of his dear Son:

1Th.5:8 So let us be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation.

Eph 6:16 Above all, take the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

Philp 4:8 Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.

From the Epistles of Peter

1Pe 5:7 Cast all your cares upon him; for he cares for you.

1 Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Master Jesus. By his great mercy he gave us new birth. into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus from the dead, that is, into an inheritance imperishable, undefiled, and unfading. It is reserved in heaven for you, who by God's power are protected through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. This brings you great joy, although you may have to suffer for a short time in various trials.

1 Peter 1: 13 set your hope completely on the grace that will be brought to you when Jesus is revealed.

1 Peter 1:23You have been born anew, not from perishable but from imperishable seed, through the living and enduring word of God

1 Peter 2:10 now you have received mercy.

1Peter 5:10 And, after you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace who called you to his eternal glory in The Messiah will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you.

1 Peter 2:8 for the Lord knows how to rescue the saints from their trials

2 Pe 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through desires.

The First Epistle of John

1John 1 :9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

1Jo 2:25 And this is the promise that he has promised us, even eternal life.

1Jo 3:1 -2 Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the children of God.

1Jn 5:4-5 For whatsoever is born of Father overcomes the world: and this is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith. Who is he that overcomes the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

1 John 4:8 For God is love.

1Jn 1:5 This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

1Jn 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and **the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanses us from all sin.**

1Jn 2:1 I am writing to you that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:

1Jn 2:2 And he is the mercy seat for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.

1Jn 2:12 I write unto you, , because your sins are forgiven you for his name's sake.

1Jn 2:25 And this is the promise that he hath promised us, even eternal life.

1Jn 3:2 Beloved, now we are the children of God, and it does not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

1Jn 3:5 And you know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin.

1Jn 3:20 For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things.

1Jn 3:23 And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another.

1Jn 4:9 In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.

1Jn 4:10 Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the mercy seat for our sins.

1Jn 4:13 Hereby know we that we dwell in him, and he in us, because he hath given us of his Spirit.

1Jn 4:14 And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son to be the Saviour of the world.

1Jn 4:15 Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God.

1Jn 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us

1Jn 4:19 We love him, because he first loved us.

1Jn 5:1 Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God

1Jn 5:4 For whatsoever is born of God overcomes the world: and this is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith.

1Jn 5:5 Who is he that overcomes the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God

1Jn 5:11 God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is found in his Son.

1Jn 5:12 He that hath the Son hath life;

1 Jn 5:20 We know that Yahshuah the Christ the Son of God has come and has shown us the true God. And because of Jesus, we now belong to the true God who gives eternal life.

From the Book of Hebrews

Heb 12:18 For you are not come unto to mount Sinai, the mountain that could not be touched, and that burned with fire, nor unto blackness, and darkness, and tempest,

Heb 12:22 But you have come to Mount Zion, the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to myriads of angels, to the assembly and congregation of the firstborn, who are enrolled in heaven, and to God, the judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous, who have been made perfect,

Heb 12:24 and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant,

Heb 9:15 And so he Jesus (Yahshuah) mediated a new covenant, so that those who are called may receive the eternal inheritance he has promised, since he died to set them free from the violations committed under the first covenant.

Heb 10:15 And the Holy Spirit also witnesses to us, for after saying,

Heb 10:16 "This is the covenant that I will establish with them after those days, says I the Lord will put my laws on their hearts and I will inscribe them on their minds,"

Heb 10:17 then he says, "Their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no longer."

Heb 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.

Heb 3:12 Jesus sanctified the people by his own blood, once and for all made them holy and placed them in the covenant

Heb. 1:2 After achieving forgiveness for the sins of all human beings, he sat down in heaven at the right side of God, the Supreme Power

Heb. 9:28 so also, after Christ offered himself once to bear the sins of many, to those who eagerly await him, he will appear a second time, not to bear sin but to bring salvation.

Heb 2:9 we see Jesus, ...now crowned with glory and honor because he suffered death, so that by God's grace he would experience death on behalf of everyone.

Heb 2:13 so that through death Jesus could destroy the one who holds the power of death (that is, the devil), and set free those who were held in slavery all their lives by their fear of death.

Heb 9:14 how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, purify our hurtful consciences.

Heb 13:5 Father has said, "I will never leave you and I will never abandon you."

Heb 13:6 So we can say with confidence, "The Lord is my helper, and I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?"

Heb 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith

Heb 10:14 who by one offering has perfected for all time those who are made holy.

Heb 13:5 God hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

Heb 4:16 Therefore let us confidently approach the throne of grace to receive mercy and find grace whenever we need help.

Heb.8:10-12 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of the faithful after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them their God, and they shall be to me a people...For I will be merciful to their evil deeds, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.

Heb.10:17 Then he adds, "I will no longer hold their sins and their disobedience against them."

Heb 10:22 We have been sprinkled with his blood to free us from a guilty, hurtful, conscience,

Heb 6:17-20 Father also bound Himself with an oath so that those he promised to help would be perfectly sure and never need to wonder whether he might change his plans. He has given us both his promise and his oath, two things we can completely count on for it is impossible for

Father to tell a lie. Now all those who flee to him to save them can take courage when they hear such assurances from Father: now they can know without doubt that he will give them the salvation He has promised them. This certain hope of being saved is a strong and trustworthy anchor for our lives connecting us with Father Himself behind the sacred curtains of heaven. (Living New Testament)

Romans 4:8 Happy, How blessed is the person whose sins the Lord will never charge against him

Blessed is the person against whom the Lord will not count his sins.

Heb 13:20 Now may the God of peace who by the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead the great shepherd of the sheep, our master Jesus (Yahshuah) the Christ, May our God Yahveh Make you perfect in every good work to do his will.

Jud 1:25 To the only wise God Yah our Divine Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen
