Commandments
of Yahshuah**

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Note to the Reader

I will call God and Jesus by their Hebrew names “Yah” and “Yahshuah”. Also sometimes I will refer to God as Eloah which is the singular of Elohim. For example: there is only one Eloah, Yah is our Eloah. My thoughts and comments are in **bold print**, or (in parenthesis).

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Introduction

Jesus (Yahshuah) revealed Yah's perfect laws. He said he came to bring the law to its fulfillment. The Law as revealed by Moses and the prophets was insufficient, incomplete. The law seen by Moses and the prophets was only seen dimly in the shadows. Jesus (Yahshuah) brought the law back to its original position of light. Yahshuah restored, and revealed the true commandments of God (Yah). Yahshuah said Yah spoke through him and gave him the (revealed, restored and fulfilled) commandments for humans. He said it is by obeying these commandments that we enter eternal life.

*"if you want to enter into life, **keep the commandments.**" (Mt. 19:17)*

Did Yahshuah mean the commandments given to Moses? No, he specifically said we were to keep "**his commandments,**" the commandments that he revealed.

- *"If you love me, keep **my commandments.**" (Jn. 14:15)*
- *"If you keep **my commandments,** you shall abide in my love." (John 15:10)*

- “Verily, verily, I say to you, If a man keeps **my sayings** (commandments), he shall never see death.” (John 8:51)
- “If a man keeps **my sayings** (commandments), he shall never taste of death.” (John 8:52)

The words of Yahshuah are the commandments of Yah.

- “The words which you hear are not mine, but the Father’s which sent me. “(Jn.14:24)
- “the Father is in me.” (Jn.14:11)
- “my Father is greater than I.” (Jn.14:28)
- “I do nothing of myself; but as my Father has taught me, I speak these things.” (Jn.8:38)
- “For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and what I should speak.” (John 12:49)
- “ the words that I speak to you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.” (Jn.14:10)
- “as the Father said to me, so I speak.”(John 12 :50)
- “ If you keep my commandments, you shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father’s commandments, and abide in his love.” (Jn.15:10)
- “And I know that his commandment is **life everlasting**: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said to me, so I speak.” (John 12:50)

So keeping the Father’s commandments revealed only by Yahshuah leads to life everlasting.

Yahshuah also said do not mix the old with the new. New wine must go into new wine skins. Do not try to put a new patch on an old garment, or an old patch on a new garment. The commandments as given by Moses and the prophet's were incomplete and only shadows of the true commandments. The old have been replaced and have have passed away. The commandments of Yahshuah are the keys to the Kingdom of Heaven. That is not to say that there is not truth in the old, only that our commandments come from the new alone.

What must I do to have eternal life?

Four passages show people asking Yahshuah "What must I do to have eternal life?" All four times he said keep the commandments.

Case 1. And a certain ruler asked him, saying, Good Master, **what shall I do to inherit eternal life?** ... *You know the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honor your father and your mother. And he said, All these have I kept from my youth up. Now when Jesus heard these things, he said to him, You lack one thing: sell all that you have, and distribute to the poor, and you shall have treasure in heaven: and come, follow me.*" (Lk.18:18-24)

Case 2. Behold, one came to him and said,
“Good teacher, **what good thing shall I do,
that I may have eternal life?**”

*.... if you want to enter into life, keep the
commandments.”*

*He said to him, “Which ones?” Jesus said, “You shall
not murder. You shall not commit adultery. You shall
not steal. You shall not offer false testimony. Honor
your father and mother. And, You shall love your
neighbor as yourself.”*

*The young man said to him, “All these things I have
observed from my youth. What do I still lack?” Jesus
said to him, “If you want to be perfect, go, sell what
you have, and give to the poor, and you will have
treasure in heaven; and come, follow me.” (Mt. 19:17-
21)*

Case 3. And, behold, a certain lawyer stood
up, and tempted him, saying, **Master, what
shall I do to inherit eternal life?**

*He said to him, What is written in the law? how do
you read it? And he answering said, You shall love
Yah your Eloah with all your heart, and with all your
soul, and with all your strength, and with all your
mind; and your neighbor as yourself. And he said to
him, You have answered right: this do, and you shall
live”.*

The lawyer then asked him who was his
neighbor and Yahshuah told the story of the
good Samaritan which concludes with your
neighbor is anyone you meet in dire need. Be

a good neighbor to those in need. (Luke 10-25-28)

Case 4. “And when he was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to him, and asked him, **Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?**

...Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother... One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me.” (Mark 10:17-21)

Notice the commandment he added about forsaking all possessions. So it is not enough to keep the all the commandments if you ignore the commandment to forsake life. You must hate your life in this world.

- “*So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsakes not all that he has, he cannot be my disciple.” (Lk.14:33)*
- “*He that loves his life shall lose it; and he that hates his life in this world shall keep it to life eternal.” (Jn.12:25)*

The world is ruled by Satan (Azazel) and lies in wickedness. Whoever loves the world or the things of this world, or his own life in this world, is the enemy of Yah and Yahshuah, and will miss the heavenly Kingdom. You

must renounce this world and hate your life in it to gain everlasting life.

The 215 Commandments

The first commandment

“You shall love Yah your Eloah with all your heart, and with all your life, and with all your strength, and with all your mind.” (Lk. 10:27)

The second commandment

You shall love your neighbor as yourself. (Lk. 10:27) (including enemies) (Mt.5:4)

“Get it? Don’t bomb them. Don’t call the cops on them. Don’t take them to court. Don’t badmouth them. Don’t go to war. Don’t fight. LOVE!” -Obadiyah Nilsson

The third commandment

Do not commit adultery. (Mt. 19:18) (or entertain lustful thoughts).(Mt.5:28)

The Fourth commandment

Do not kill. (Mt. 19:18) (or even remain angry or call anyone a bad name) (Mt.5:22)

The fifth commandment

Do not steal. (Mt. 19:18)

The sixth commandment

Defraud not (deceptively make gain of someone) (Mark 10:19)

The seventh commandment

Do not bear false witness. (Mt. 19:18)

The eighth commandment

Honor your father and your mother. (Mt. 19:18)

Honor means enrich them-Obadiyah Nilsson

The ninth commandment-Be spirit born (begotten from above)

“Verily, verily, I say to you, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. .. Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.” (John 3:3 & 5)

(Water is the words Yahshuah spoke. When you hear his words, and do them, you are spirit born from above).

“The words that I speak are spirit and life.” (John 6:63)

(There are two Greek words for life: psuche life (body life) and Zoe life which is eternal life. Here Yahshuah is saying his words are Zoe or eternal life).

The tenth commandment

“whosoever he be of you that forsakes not all that he has, he cannot be my disciple.” (Lk. 14:33)

11. Read every word of Yah to live

“It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of Yah.’” (Mt. 4:4)

12. Do not try to force Yah to do your will

"You shall not tempt Yah your Elohah." (Lk.4:12)

13. Preach to the poor free of charge

"preach the gospel to the poor." (Lk.4:19)

14. "Heal the brokenhearted." (Lk.4:19)

15. Preach deliverance to the slaves

"preach deliverance to the captives." (Lk.4:19)

16. "Open the eyes of the blind." (Lk.4:18)

17. Set free the innocent who are incarcerated.

"set at liberty them that are bruised." (Lk.4:19)

18. Preach that Yah's doors are open and he is welcoming repentant sinners with open arms.

"preach the acceptable year of the Lord." (Lk.4:18)

19. Preach the kingdom of Yah (Lk.4:43)

"Seek you first the Kingdom of Yah, and his righteousness." (Mt.6:33)

20. Do not try to mix Old Covenant laws and theology with the new garment of the New Covenant or vise versa

“No man puts a piece of a new garment upon an old; if otherwise, then both the new make a rent, and the piece that was taken out of the new agrees not with the old.” (Lk.5:36) New wine goes into new wine flasks.” (Mt.9:17) . That does not mean that there is no truth in the old, but that our commandments come only from the new.

21. Stay poor

“Blessed be you poor: for yours is the kingdom of Yah.” (Lk. 6:20)

22. Stay humble

“Blessed are the poor in spirit.” (Mt. 5:3)

23. Stay hungry

“Blessed are you that hunger now: for you shall be filled.” (Lk.6:21) (make hunger a friend not an enemy, eat light and fast).

“Hunger and thirst for righteousness.” (Mt.5:6)

24. Avoid a life devoted to humor

“Woe to you that laugh now! for you shall mourn and weep. “ (Lk.6:25)

25. Live in mourning

“Blessed are those who mourn for they shall be comforted.” (Mt.5:4) (mourn to see all the humans caught in the love of the world and slaves of sin)

26. Be humble

*“Blessed are the meek for they shall inherit the earth.”
(Mt.5:5) (the promised land-the kingdom of
heaven)*

27. Be Merciful

*“Blessed are the merciful for they shall receive
mercy.” (Mt.5:8)*

28. Be a peacemaker

*“Blessed are the peacemakers for they shall be called
the children of Yah.” (Mt.5:9)*

29. Rejoice when you are persecuted

*“Blessed are you, when men shall hate you, and
when they shall separate you from their company,
and shall reproach you, and cast out your name as
evil, for the Son of man's sake. Rejoice you in that
day, and leap for joy.” (Lk.6:232)*

**30. Do not be a man pleaser who seeks the
praises of people**

*“Woe to you, when all men shall speak well of you! for
so did their fathers to the false prophets.” (Lk.6:26)*

31. “Love your enemies.” (Lk.6:27)

**32. “Do good to them that hate you.”
(Lk.6:27)**

33. “Bless those that curse you.” (Lk.6:28)

34 “Pray for those who despitefully use you.” (Lk.6:28)

35. “And to him that smites you on the one cheek offer also the other; (Lk.6:29)

36. “and him that takes away your cloak forbid not to take your coat also”. (Lk.6:29)

37. If a thief takes your property do not try to get it back

“and of him that takes away your goods ask them not again.” (Lk.6:30)

38. “Give to every man that asks of you.” (Lk.6:30) (unless you know they will do evil with the gift).

39. Do not ask for a loan to be repaid or charge interest

“lend, hoping for nothing again. “(Lk.6:34)

40. Obey The Golden Rule

“And as you would that men should do to you, do you also to them likewise.” (Lk.6:31)

41. Be salt (Mt.5:13)

42. Be light (Mt.5:14)

43. “Judge not and you shall not be judged” (Lk.6:37) (It is not your place to decide the fate of others, or punish them.)

44. Do not decide a matter based on appearances but find out the facts.

“Judge not according to the appearances, but judge righteous judgments.” (John 7:24)

45. “Condemn not and you shall not be condemned.” (Lk.6:37)

46. Forgive and you shall be forgiven. If you do not forgive everyone you cannot be forgiven.

*“For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their sins, **your Father will not forgive your sins** (Mt.6:14)*

“His lord was angry, and delivered him to the tormentors, until he should pay all that was due to him. So my heavenly Father will also do to you, if you Do not each forgive your brother from your hearts for his misdeeds.” (Mt.18:34-35)

47. Be reconciled before you pray“

If therefore you are offering your gift at the altar, and there remember that your brother has anything against you, leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.” (Mt.5:23-24)

48. Make peace quickly with an enemy

“Agree with your adversary quickly, while you are with him in the way; lest perhaps the prosecutor deliver you to the judge, and the judge deliver you to the officer, and you be cast into prison.” (Mt.5:25)

Pay off all debts immediately; incur no debt.

49. Do not given in to sexual cravings and mental lusting

“but I tell you that everyone who gazes at a woman (or man) to lust after her/him has committed adultery with her/him already in his heart.” (Mt.5:28)

50. Swear no oaths

“but I tell you, Do not swear at all: neither by heaven, for it is the throne of Yah; nor by the earth, for it is the footstool of his feet; nor by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King.” (Mt.5:34-35)
(Make no vows, or promises).

51. Resist not evil people

“Do not make use of force against an evil man.” (Mt.5:39)

ASV: but I say unto you, resist not him that is .

“Whoever compels you to go one mile, go with him two.” (Mt.5:41)

52. Give

“Give to him who asks you, and Do not turn away him who desires to borrow from you.” (Mt.5:42)

Give and you will receive pressed down shaken together and running over. (Lk.6:38)

(desire spiritual blessings not worldly goods).

53. “Therefore you shall be perfect, just as your Father in heaven is perfect.” (Mt.5:48)

54. Do not major on the faults in others

“And why do behold you the mote that is in your brother’s eye, but perceive not the beam that is in your own eye?” (Lk.6:41)

55. Give alms in secret. (Mt.6:1)

56. Pray in secret. (Mt.6:6)

57. Fast in secret. (Mt.6:16)

58. Do not seek, or store, treasures - wealth and property

“Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon the earth, where moth and rust consume, and where thieves break through and steal.” (Mt.6:19)

(Lay up treasures in heaven by kind, secret deeds).

56. Do not serve Dame Fortune, the goddess of wealth and prosperity

“No one can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other; or else he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You can’t serve both Yah and Mammon.” (the pagan Queen of Wealth)

60. Do the Father's will

"Not everyone who says to me, "Lord, Lord," will enter into the Kingdom of Heaven; but he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.." (Mt.7:21)

"And why call you me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say to do?" (Lk.6:46)

61. You build on the solid rock by doing what Yahshuah said to do

*"Everyone therefore who hears these words of mine, **and does them**, I will liken him to a wise man, who built his house on a rock." (Mt.7:24)*

62. Beware of people." (MT.10:17)

63. When arrested Do not plan a speech

"But when they deliver you up, Do not be anxious how or what you will say, for it will be given you in that hour what you will say." (Mt.10:19)

64. Flee when trouble comes

"But when they persecute you in this city, flee into the next." (Mt.10:23)

65. Die for Yah and Yahshuah

"He who seeks his life will lose it; and he who loses his life for my sake will find it." (Mt.10:39)

66. Submit humbly to the yoke of Yahshuah

"Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart." (Mt. 11:29)

67. Do not speak foolish, nasty, idle words

“I tell you that every idle word that men speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment.”

(Mt. 12:36)

68. Beware of worry and the deceitfulness of riches

*“the **cares** of this age and the **deceitfulness** of riches choke the word, and he (the believer) becomes unfruitful.*

(spiritually dead-out of the kingdom forever).

69. Do not attack and expose false teachers

“Leave them alone. They are blind guides of the blind. If the blind guide the blind, both will fall into a pit.” (Mt.15:14)

70. Pass on the keys of the kingdom (the commandments of Yahshuah)

“I will give to you the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven.” (Mt. 16:19)

The Commandments are the keys.

71. Give Up sex

“there are eunuchs who made themselves eunuchs for the Kingdom of Heaven’s sake. He who is able to receive it, let him receive it.” (Mt. 19:12)

72. You are not required to pay tithes and offerings

“What do you think, Simon (Peter)? From whom do the kings of the earth receive toll or tribute? From their children, or from strangers?” Peter said to him,

“From strangers.” Jesus said to him, “Therefore the children are exempt.” (Mt 17:27)

73. You must become like a child

“Most certainly I tell you, unless you turn, and become as little children, you will in no way enter into the Kingdom of Heaven..” (Mt 18:3)

74. “Go therefore to the intersections of the highways, and as many as you may find, invite to the marriage feast.” (Mt.22.9)

75. Believers are all equals –brothers and sisters-have no hierarchies, or leaders

“But Jesus called them to him, and said, You know that the princes of the Gentiles exercise dominion over them, and they that are great exercise authority upon them. But it shall not be so among you.” (Mt.20:25-26)

“all of you are brothers.”(and sister) (Mt 23:8)

76. “But Do not you be called ‘Rabbi, for one is your teacher, the Christ (messiah).” (Mt 23:8)

That includes titles like Reverend, Doctor, your honor, cardinal, Bishop, Monseignor, your highness, sire, sire, lord, captain, chief, boss, president etc.

77. “Call no man on the earth your father, for one is your Father, he who is in heaven.” (Mt 23:9)

That includes Mr. Mrs.

Patriot comes from the Latin Pater and a patriot is a father lover. He loves the father land. Whoever loves the world is the enemy of God.

78. “Neither be called masters, *for one is your master, the Christ (messiah).” (MT 23:10)*

79. Do not let anyone fool you

“Jesus answered them, “Be careful that no one leads you astray. For many will come in my name, saying, ‘I am the Messiah,’ and will lead many astray.” (Mt 24:1-5)

(Many false Christians will try to deceive you).

“Then if any man tells you, ‘Behold, here is the Christ,’ or, ‘There,’ Do not believe it. If therefore they tell you, ‘ Behold, he is in the wilderness,’ Do not go out; ‘Behold, he is in the inner chambers,’ Do not believe it.” (Mt.24:2-26)

80. Watch (Mt.24:42)

81. Feed the people the Gospel (Mt.24:45)

82. Do not join the wicked in gluttony and intoxicating.

*But and if that evil servant shall say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming;
And shall begin to smite his fellow servants, and to eat and drink with the drunken; The lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of And shall cut him asunder, and appoint him his portion with the*

hypocrites: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. (Mt.24:48)

83. Do not hide your spiritual knowledge-use it or lose it

"Take away therefore the talent from him" (Mt.25:28)

84. Feed the hungry (as if they were Yahshuah himself)

85. Clothe the naked (as if they were Yahshuah himself)

86. Visit the sick (as if they were Yahshuah himself)

87. Visit the prisoners (as if they were Yahshuah himself)

88. Help foreigners in your country (as if they were Yahshuah himself)

89. Be careful what you listen to

*"He said to them, "Take heed what you hear. With whatever measure you measure, it will be measured to you, and more will be given to you who hear."
"(Mark 4:24)*

90. Shake the dust

“Whoever will not receive you nor hear you, as you depart from there, shake off the dust that is under your feet for a testimony against them.” (Mark 6:11)

91. Do not teach man made commandments, doctrines and traditions

“But in vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.” (Mark 7:7)

92. When you hear of wars “be not troubled.” (Mark 13:7)

(Notice believers only *hear* about wars, they are not in them fighting them).

93. Show hospitality

“See this woman? I entered into your house, you gave me no water for my feet: but she has washed my feet with tears, and wiped them with the hair of her head. You gave me no kiss: but this woman since the time I came in has not ceased to kiss my feet. My head with oil you did not anoint: but this woman has anointed my feet with ointment.” (Lu.7:44)

94. Love much so you will be forgiven much

“Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much.”(Lk.7:47)

95. Let your light shine

“No man, when he has lighted a candle, covers it with a vessel, or puts it under a bed; but sets it on a

candlestick, that they which enter in may see the light.” (Lk 8:16)

“For nothing is secret, that shall not be made manifest; neither any thing hid, that shall not be known and come abroad.” (Lk 8:17)

96. “Hear the word of Yah and do it.”
(Lk.8:21)

97. Deny yourself

“If any man will come after me, let him deny himself.”
(Lk.9:23)

98. Surrender your earthly life

“For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life for my sake, the same shall save it.” (Lk.9:24)

99. Be kind to children

“Whosoever shall receive this child in my name receives me: and whosoever shall receive me receives him that sent me.” (Lk.9:48)

“It would be better for him to be thrown into the sea with a millstone tied around his neck than for him to cause one of these little ones to sin.” (Luke 17:2-3)

100. Do not focus on having a place to call home on this earth

*“Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man has no where to lay his head.”
(Luke 9:57-58)*

101. “pray you therefore to the Lord of the harvest (Yah), that he would send forth laborers into his harvest.” (Lk .10:2)

102. Be as gentle as a lamb

“Go your way: behold, I send you forth as lambs among wolves.” (Lk.10:3)

103. Do not fuss when offered food

“eat such things as are set before you.” (Lk.10:8)

104. Pray to the father. (Lk.10:2) Hallow his name and publish it. His name is Yah.

Sing unto God, sing praises to his name: extol him that rideth upon the heavens by his name YAH, and rejoice before him. (Psalm 68:4)

105. Pray for his kingdom to come to the earth. (Lk.10:2)

106. Pray for his will to be done on the earth. (Lk.10:2)

107. Pray for your daily bread. (Lk.10:3)

108. Pray for your sins to be forgiven (Lk.10:4)

109. Pray to see the way out of temptations.
(Lk. 10:4)

110. Ask and it shall be given. (Lk.10:9)

111. Seek and you shall find. (Lk.10:9)

112. Knock and the door shall be opened to you. (Lk.10:9)

113. Ask for a portion of Father's spirit
"your heavenly Father will give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?" (Lk.11:13)

114. Gather people to the Father
"and he that gathers not with me scatters." (Lk.10:23)

115. Once you are exorcised of demons Do not leave the door open by sinning again
"When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walks through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he says, I will return to my house whence I came out. And when he cometh, he finds it swept and garnished. Then goes he, and takes with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in, and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first." (Mt.12:43)

116. “Hear the word of Yah and keep it.”
(Lk.10:28)

117. Keep your eyes focused only on the father

“The light of the body is the eye: therefore when your eye is single, your whole body also is full of light; but when your eye is evil, your body also is full of darkness.” (Lk.10:34)

If you have one eye on Father and one on the world you will lose them both.

118. Clean the inside and outside of yourself

“did not he that made that which is without make that which is within also?” (Lk.10:40)

119. Do not build, or visit, monuments or statues to heroes

“Woe to you! For you build the sepulchers of the prophets, and your fathers killed them. Truly you bear witness that you allow the deeds of your fathers: for they indeed killed them, and you build their sepulchers.” (Lk.10:47)

120. Do not hoard, lock away or sell the knowledge of Yah that you have received

“you have taken away the key of knowledge: you entered not in yourselves, and them that were entering in you hindered.” (Lk.10:52)

Freely you have received, freely give (Mt.10:8)

121. Beware of the doctrines of the Pharisees, Sadducees and Herodians

(Mark 8:15 & Mt.16:11)

- The Pharisees had added many of the traditions of the elders from the oral tradition to their religion and were teaching them as commandments from God. Yahshuah said they were lovers of money. They taught that after death the soul was immortal. They believed in endless eternal punishment. Yahshuah always described them as having an outward show of holiness, but inwardly they were greedy hypocrites.
- The Sadducees were Hellenizers and secular. They loved everything Greek. They were fiercely in favor of Capital punishment. They denied an afterlife, and did not believe in angels or demons.
- The Herodians were loyal to the Herod dynasty. They loved all things Roman. Herod seems to have thought he was the Messiah. He also was a usurper to the throne. Herod was not Jewish, but an Edomite and had no right to the throne. He was an adulterer. There is a hint of pedophilia with Salome his step daughter.

122. “Be not afraid of them that kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do. “Do not be afraid of those who can kill your body.” (Lk.12:4)

123. Fear Yah

“Fear him, which after he has killed has power to cast into hell.” (Lk.12:4)

124. Yahshuah said “Confess me before men.” (Lk.12:8)

125. Never deny Yahshuah

“But he that denies me before men shall be denied before the angels of Yah.” (Lk.12:9)

126. Never blaspheme against the Father. He is the holiest of all spirits

“him that blasphemes against Father’s Holy Spirit it shall not be forgiven.” (Lk.12:10)

127. Do not be a judge, jurist, or serve in the legal profession

*“And Yahshuah said to him, Man, who made me a judge or a divider over you?”
(Lk.12:14)*

128. Do not want, desire, or covet anything of the earth

*“And he said to them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man’s life consists not in the abundance of the things which he possesses.”
(Lk.12:15)*

129. “Take no thought for your life, what you shall eat.” (Mt.6:25)

130. “Take no thought for your body, what you shall wear.” (Mt.6:25)

131. “Neither be you of a doubtful mind.”
(Lk.12:29)

132. “Sell what you have and give alms.”
(Lk.12:33)

133. Be ready

“And you yourselves like men that wait for their master, when he will return from the wedding; that when he comes and knocks they may open to him immediately” (Lk.12:36)

134. When you are invited to a wedding (or any gala event) do not sit in a seat of honor, but pick a humble seat. (Lk.14:8)

135. Invite the Poor to your feasts

“But when you make a feast, call the poor, the maimed, the lame, the blind .” (Lk.14:13)

136. “Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in.”
(Lk.14:23)

137. Be as innocent as a toddler about sin

“Verily I say to you, whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God as a little child shall in no wise enter therein.” (Lk.18:17)

138. Seek out the lost one

“What man of you, having an hundred sheep, if he lose one of them, doth not leave the ninety and nine

in the wilderness, and go after that which is lost, until he find it?" (Lk.15:4)

139. Use money as tainted as it is to prepare a heavenly habitation for yourself

*"And I say to you, Make to yourselves friends of the mammon of unrighteousness; that, when you fail, they may receive you into everlasting habitations."
(Lk.16:9)*

(Wealth is deceitful and unrighteous)

140. Ignore what the world calls "great" like art, movies, celebrities, leaders etc.

"for that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of Yah." (Lk.16:15)

141. Preach the Kingdom message

"The law and the prophets were until John: since that time the kingdom of Yah is preached. " (Lk.16:16)

(Yah is the king, Yahshuah is the prince, the commandments of Yahshuah are the articles of our constitution. You enter the kingdom by lovingly obeying them).

142. Press into the kingdom

"and every man presses into it. " (Lk.16:16)

143. Marriage is between one male and one female

"Have you not read, that he which made them at the beginning made them male and female, And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and

shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh? “(Mt. 19:4-5)

144. Do not divorce

- *“What therefore God has joined together, let not man put asunder.” (Mt. 19:6)*
- *“Whosoever divorces his wife, and marries another, commits adultery: and whosoever marries her that is divorced from her husband commits adultery. “ (Lk. 16:18)*
- *“And if a woman divorces her husband, and marries to another, she commits adultery.” (Mark 10:11)*

145. You must divorce if

*And I say to you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, **except** it be for **fornication**, (Matthew 19:9)*

The Greek word for fornication is *porneia* which in Hebrew is *Zanah*. Yahshuah is validating the ancient Zanah Code in Leviticus and if anyone is in a marriage that violates this code they must divorce.

146. If you marry- Your Father or Mother you must divorce.

147. If you marry- Your Step-Father or Step-Mother, you must divorce.

148. If you marry- Your Grandfather or Grandmother, you must divorce.

149. If you marry- Your step-grandfather or step-grandmother, you must divorce.

150. If you marry- Your Brother or Sister, you must divorce.

151. If you marry- Your half brother or half sister, you must divorce.

152. If you marry- Your step-brother or step-sister (unless there is no blood connection) , you must divorce..

153. You may not marry- Your step-daughter or step-son, you must divorce.

154. If you marry- Your Uncle or Aunt, you must divorce.

155. If you marry- Your In-Laws (Mother-in-law, father-in law sister-in-law, brother-in-law, daughter- in- law, son-in-law) , you must divorce..

156. If you marry- a Prostitute (either male or female) , you must divorce. (Lev.19:29, 21:14,)

157. If you marry- anyone married, or divorced, whose first mate is still alive, you must divorce. (Lev.18:20, Mt.19:6, Mark 10:11-12, Lk 16:18).

158. If you marry- A person of the same sex, you must divorce. (Lev.18:22)

159. If you marry- marry an animal, you must divorce. (lev.18:23)

160. Feed beggars earthly food and spiritual food

“And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores, And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man’s table. “ (Lk.16:20-21)

161. Meekly confront those who offend you

*“If your brother trespass against you, rebuke him. “
(Lk.17:3)*

162. Do not pester Yah

“by her continual coming she weary me.” (Lk.18:5)

163. When you Pray be humble, say,

“Yah be merciful to me a sinner.” (Lk.18:13)

164. Prepare for delay

- *“A certain nobleman went into a **far country** to receive for himself a kingdom, and to return. “
(Lk.19:12)*
- *“For the kingdom of heaven is as a man traveling into a **far country**.” (Mt.25:14)*
- *“My master is staying away **a long time**.”
(Mt.24:48)*
- *“And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.”
(Mt.24:14)*

165. Work hard, or lose it all

“For I say to you, That to every one which has shall be given; and from him that has not, even that he has shall be taken away from him.” (Lk. 19:26)

166. Do not mix your ministry with commercial products

“make not my Father’s house an house of merchandise.” (Jn.2:16)

"My house is the house of prayer for all nations: but you have made it a den of thieves." (Lk.19:46)

167. Give nothing to Caesar

"Render therefore to Caesar the things which be Caesar's, and to God the things which be God's." (Lk.20:25)

Caesar was a pagan God and Yahshuah was saying give the pagan god back his coins, but give 100% of your life to Yah. If Yah gets 100% what is left for Caesar? Nothing.

168. Be Patient

"In your patience possess your souls." (Lk.21:19)

169. Preach repentance and forgiveness of sins to all nations in Yahshuah's name

"And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations." (Lk. 24:47)

170. Do not preach Condemnation

"For Yah sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved." (John 3:17)

171. Do not worship Yah with rituals and ceremonies, days and feasts

"the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth." (Jn.4:24)

172. Yah is not resting on the 7th day so it is not required

"My Father works hitherto, and I work." (Jn.5:17)

173. Honor the son

“all men should honor the Son, even as they honor the Father.” (Jn.5:23)

174. Do not honor one another

“How can you believe, which receive honor one of another, and seek not the honor that cometh from God only?” (Jn.5:44)

175. Labor for eternal things not earthly

“Labor not for the food which perishes, but for that food which endures to everlasting life.” (Jn.6:27)
(Work only enough to provide the barest of necessities for yourself and family).

176. Believe that Yah took Yahshuah to heaven, instructed him and sent him to save us.

“And no man has ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man.” (John 3:13)

(So at sometime in his youth, Father took Yahshuah up to heaven to instruct him. He ascended before he descended).

177. Believe that Yahshuah was a ransom for your sins

*“the Son of man came not to be ministered to, but to minister, and to present his life as a **ransom** for many.” (Matthew 20:28)*

A ransom is different from a sacrifice.
Yahshuah never used the word sacrifice
except to say Yah did not want sacrifices.

“I will have mercy, and not sacrifice.”
(Mt.12:7)

A ransom was an exchange of a living person.
Father did not sacrifice Yahhuah, and he did
not sacrifice himself. Satan and his evil forces
killed Yahshuah.

178. Do the work of Yah

*“Then said they to him, What shall we do, that we
might work the works of God? Jesus answered and
said to them, This is the work of God, that you believe
on him whom he has sent. (Jn.6:28-29)*

179. Do the Will of Yah

*“I will arise and go to my father, and will say to him,
Father, I have sinned against heaven.” (Lk.15:18)*

*“whosoever he be of you that forsakes not all that he
has, he cannot be my disciple.” (Lk.14:33)*

The prodigal son is a good example of
someone doing the Father’s will. Once he left
the pig sty he never looked back, or went back
but went straight for his father’s house. We
must leave everything in this world behind and
go straight to the Father’s house. Yah’s will is
summed up in two words **“Come”** and
“forsake”.)

180. Eat, breathe, sleep, do, and live the words of Yahshuah

"I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eats of this bread, he shall live for ever."

(His words are the bread, eating the bread-words leads to immortality).

181. Lovingly obey his words

(they give you spiritual flesh and blood for the new spiritual life).

"Whoso eats my flesh, and drinks my blood, has eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day."

(Jn.6:54)

182. Preach that the world is controlled by Satan (Azazel) and is evil

"The world... hates me, because I testify of it, that the works thereof are evil."

Even though Christendom is ruled by the beast, there are still some true Christians trapped within the beast who are struggling to be free, and to do right.

183. Do the Father's will and you will know the truth

"If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God." (Jn.7:17)

(His will is for you to love him and forsake the world).

184. Do not seek your own fame

“He that speaks of himself seeks his own glory: but he that seeks his (Yah’s) glory that sent him, the same is true.” (Jn.7:18)

185. The words of Yahshuah are living water

“Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come to me, and drink.” (Jn.7:37)

186. Execute punishment on no one, especially do not inflict capital punishment

“He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her. “ (Jn.8:7)

187. Do not remain a slave of sin

“Verily, verily, I say to you, Whosoever commits sin is the servant of sin. And the servant abides not in the house for ever.” (Jn.8:34)

188. Keep on obeying (it leads to life).

“Verily, verily, I say to you, If a man keeps my sayings, he shall never see death.” (Jn.8:51)

189. Yahshuah is the only door to the father

“I am the door, if any man enters in he shall be saved.” (Jn. 10:9)

If you believe in Yahshuah, (that is unite with and obey him), you will never see death.

“And whosoever lives and believes in me shall never die.” (Jn.11:26)

190. Keep the Commandments spoken by Yahshuah (for they are the Father’s commandments).

*“And I know that **his commandment is life everlasting**: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said to me, so I speak.” (Jn.14:10)*

191. Love with the kind of love Yahshuah showed

“A new commandment I give to you, That you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.” (Jn.13:34)

192. Stay Calm

Yahshuah said “Let not your heart be troubled: you believe in God, believe also in me.” (Jn. 14:1)

193. Love Yahshuah (Love is as Love does).

*“If you love me, **keep my commandments.**” (Jn.14:15)*

“Jesus answered and said to him, If a man loves me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come to him, and make our abode with him.” (Jn. 14:23)

194. Abide in Yahshuah and bring glory to the Father

“I am the vine, you are the branches: He that abides in me, and I in him, the same brings forth much fruit.” (Jn.15:5)

195. Abide in Yahshuah's love

"If you keep my commandments, you shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love." (Jn.15:10)

196. Be Yahshuah's Friends

"You are my friends, if you do whatsoever I command you." (Jn.15:14)

197. Be Yahshuah's family

"For whosoever shall do the will of God, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother." (Mark 3:35)

198. Pray in Yahshuah's name

"Whatsoever you shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you." (Jn.15:16)

199. Do not be offended by Yahshuah or the Gospel

"These things have I spoken to you, that you should not be offended." (Mt.11:6)

200. Preach against the world's sins, explain how to be righteous by keeping Yahshuah's commandments and explain the coming day of Judgment

- *"he will reprove the world of sin (the chief sin is to reject Yahshuah),*
- *and of righteousness (declaring that Yahshuah was innocent),*

- *and of judgment (for Azazel has been judged and found guilty and will be punished) (Jn.16:8)*

201. Stay peaceful and cheerful in tribulations

“These things I have spoken to you, that in me you might have peace. In the world you shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.” (Jn. 16:33)

202. Teach the Father’s, name it is “Yah”

“I have manifested your name to the men which you gave me.” (Jn.17:6)

203. Do not fight in the wars of men

“My kingdom is not of this world: if my kingdom were of this world, then my servants would fight.”(John 18:36)

204. Teach people to obey these commandments of Yahshuah throughout the whole world

*“Go ye therefore, and teach all nations.” (Mt. 28:19)
“teach them to observe all things that I commanded you.” (Mt.28:20)*

“Whoever, therefore, shall break one of these least commandments, and teach others to do so, shall be called least in the Kingdom of Heaven; but whoever shall do and teach them shall be called great in the Kingdom of Heaven.” (Mt.5:19)

Teach only willing people Don't cast your pearls before swine.

205. Be zealous to keep them in a spirit of fervent love

"For I tell you that unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, there is no way you will enter into the Kingdom of Heaven." (Mt. 5:20)

206. Take up your cross beam (execution stake)

"And whosoever doth not bear his cross (beam), and come after me, cannot be my disciple." (Lk.14:27)

"and take up his cross (beam) daily, and follow me." (Lk.9:23)

"He that loves his life shall lose it; and he that hates his life in this world shall keep it to life eternal." (Jn.12:25)

"If any man comes to me, and does not hate his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, and even his own life also, he cannot be my disciple." (Lk.14:26)

207. Avoid the last pit-fall (pride)

"when you shall have done all those things which are commanded you, say, We are unprofitable servants: we have done that which was our duty to do." (Lk.17:10)

208. Know Yah

(All the commandments are to help you know and love Yah and have eternal life).

“And this is life eternal, that they might know you the only true Elohah, and Yahshuah the messiah, whom you have sent.” (Jn. 17:3)

(Yah is the only true Elohah and Yahshuah is his human son, the Messiah. To know them is to love them and obey them and be with them for all eternity).

209. Do Not Accuse Yah of Murder

Do not teach the lie of substitutionary Atonement. Yah did not sacrifice his son to himself to appease himself. Yah wants Mercy and not sacrifice. Azazel killed Yahshuah. Yahshuah offered himself as a living ransom not a sacrifice.

210. You No Longer Need to Keep the Sabbath

“The Sabbath was made for man.” (Mark 2:27) The Sabbath was a sign between the Israelis and Yah (Exo 31:17), but since they are no longer his chosen people, the sign has ended.

211. Worship only Yah

“for it is written, You shall worship Yah your Elohah, and him only shall you serve.” (Lk.4:8)

“But for us there is only one Elohah the Father.”

Honor the son.

“all men should honor the Son, even as they honor the Father.” (Jn.5:23)

(so we worship only the father and honor the son)

Commandments with Promises

212. *“He that has my commandments, and keeps them, he it is that loves me: and he that loves me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.” (Jn. 14:21)*

213. *“If you keep my commandments, you shall abide in my love.” (John 15:10)*

214. *“Jesus answered and said to him, If a man loves me, he will keep my word: and my Father will love him, and we will come to him, and make our abode with him. (Jn. 14:23)*

215. Prepare to be hated and killed for speaking and doing these things

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
